## Frequent Flyer Survey: Traveling Post-COVID-19

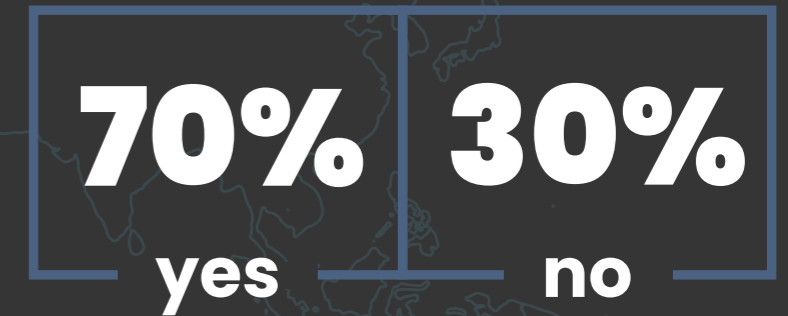
Survey of more than 2,000 frequent flyers was conducted online by Xenophon Strategies, from July 26, 2021 through August 12, 2021.



**1 in 10**

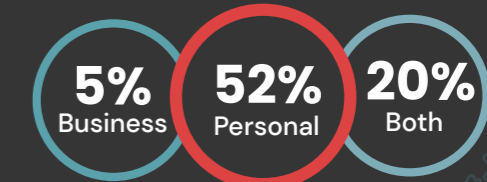
frequent flyers **do not** intend to get vaccinated
